

New Liquor Distribution Centre Media Event

Goal: To inform and raise awareness on the building and opening of the new liquor distribution centre to AGLC staff, industry, stakeholders and the general public.

Opportunities:

- An opportunity to tell the story on the building of our new liquor distribution centre.
- The event provides an opportunity to wave the story about the 25th anniversary on Alberta's unique liquor model.
- An opportunity to recognize collectively how key stakeholders have contributed to the success of Alberta's liquor model over the past 25 years.
- Opportunity to raise the profile of AGLC's efforts in building a strong, vibrant liquor industry while balancing the importance of social responsibility for liquor.

Recommended Approach:

A media event would take place September 19 in the morning to celebrate the completion of the new liquor warehouse. Alain Maisonneuve, President & CEO of AGLC and Minister Ceci would start the proceedings by having a dock bay opened and each picking up case of ALSA honey gin from a delivery truck (or walk into the warehouse with a case in hand). The Minister and Alain would then carry their case of beer to the racking system to have it "racked". Various representatives (AGLC, GOA, ALSA) would then say a few words (no more than 2-3 minutes each). After speeches are done, photo opportunity with Minister/Alain with honey gin to take place near racks. Scrum to occur after the photo opportunity, followed by media being invited to join the first floor tour with ALIC VIP delegates. VIP ALIC stakeholders and key stakeholders will be invited to attend the media event. This is done to recognize collectively how key stakeholders have contributed to the success of Alberta's liquor model over the past 25 years.
