Government Update

Ivonne reported that with the new Premier and a likely election in 6 months, the agenda for Government will not be overly responsive to ALSA issues.

There have been some strong indications that the Card scanning issues have been reduced if not eliminated.

The 7-11 issue continues and a meeting with 7-11 at their request is planned for early December and Ivonne invited Board members especially Edmonton based to join her.

The advent of this meeting prompted a further discussion regarding planning for advocacy activities in the immediate future.

It was determined that overall status quo was warranted and that ALSA would not push on the 10% non-alcohol threshold. There were some areas of concern that might be addressed by AGLC

being encouraged to ensure restaurants delivering alcohol are being properly monitored for compliance. Also, to ensure that restaurants which are serving alcohol within the rules especially those that have open displays of alcohol. Further clarification regarding whether restaurant sales are single serving or not as well as to whether they are abiding by the requirements of what is their primary business. Are they a liquor store selling pizza, or a pizza place selling liquor?

Ivonne will advise the board of the outcomes from the meeting with 7-11 in December.
