### ARTICLE 2-MEMBERSHIP

#### (a) Active Members:

Each owner of a retail liquor store operating in Alberta is eligible for one Active Membership per store. Under the Liquor Control Act in force at the time of these By-Laws, the owners of such stores are issued a Class D license. An Owner of an Agency or Duty-free store (as defined in the liquor Control Act), are not entitled to Active Membership in respect of such store. Each Member must appoint, and register with the Association, one individual to represent the Member, which individual shall be a shareholder, partner, full-time manager or full-time employee of the owner. By notice in writing to the Association, owners may replace such representative from time to time. Where any owner, directly or indirectly, has an interest (including an interest by way of shareholding or partnership) in more than one retail liquor store, then a separate Active Membership must be obtained and maintained such that there is one Active Membership per store related to such owner. The same individual may represent more than one Active Member. An Associated Group of Stores shall name the same individual as the representative for each of the associated stores within the group.
